



# TECH TIP: SAMSUNG RESIDENTIAL REFRIGERATOR (Adjusting setting to prevent cooling interruption)

## ISSUE:

The Samsung Residential Refrigerator has a Peak Demand function that when enabled could cause the refrigerator's cooling cycle to get interrupted causing the temperature to rise unexpectedly.

**IF** this happens **OR** to prevent this from happening, ensure that the Peak Demand function is turned off.



## Turning on or off the Peak Demand function

You can turn on or off the Peak Demand function. For more information on the Peak Demand function, see the **SMART GRID Function (Demand Response)** (applicable models only) section.

1. Tap any button ( < , O, or > ) to wake up the display.
  - This step may not apply to some models.
2. Tap O until the Peak Demand indicator blinks.
3. Tap < or > to turn on or off the function.
  - Tap < to turn it on.
  - Tap > to turn it off.
4. Wait for 5 seconds or tap O to confirm your selection.
  - The Peak Demand indicator stops blinking.
